Here is another type of google search you can do to find the free computer training, tutorials and books that you are looking for.

For your main keywords use the name of a book on the subject you are searching in double quotes, followed by (pdf OR zip OR chm OR rar) -purchase -buy -shopping -review -cart -price -sale. So, for example, doing a search for Excel, you would enter the following into google's search box: "excel book" (pdf OR zip OR chm OR rar) -purchase -buy -shopping -review -cart -price -sale.
