Principles of design and color as they apply to screen presentations will be included. Also included are assignments for each lesson.

The student will learn the basics of programming in the C# language, what the .NET Common Language Runtime is and how it works, how to use many of the .NET framework classes, how to use ADO.NET to access relational databases, and how to use ASP.NET to build web applications and services. In addition the student will learn about XML and how it is used in .NET. Most aspects of web applications and services will be covered: architecture, design, coding, data access, etc. The architecture of the .NET development platform will be discussed, as well as practical development issues such as debugging, deployment and security. Design for scalability, performance and availability will be emphasized.

This means that a page can respond immediately to user actions, such as a mouse click, without having to retrieve an entire new page from the server.

In an Introduction to Dynamic HTML, 3 main components of Dynamic HTML authoring are demonstrated:

1. Positioning; precisely placing blocks of content on the page and, if desired, moving these blocks around (strictly speaking, a subset of style modifications).
2. Style modifications; on-the-fly altering the aesthetics of content on the page.
3. Event handling; how to relate user events to changes in positioning or other style modifications.
